

Placitas Community Library Art Committee
Legacy Exhibition Series Procedures

The Placitas Community Library's Art Committee will annually recognize a local artist whose accomplishments as a creative have delighted audiences in Placitas and beyond. Through their art, they have brought positive attention to our community.

The committee has reserved the January exhibition in the Gracie Lee Community Room for this purpose. Artists will be selected with an eye to the following criteria:

- Long-term Placitas resident (10-years plus)
- Established artist recognized within their field
- Consistent body of original work in any medium
- Willingness to cooperate with the committee to enhance the exhibition by being present at the reception and speaking about the work and the artist's process or designating a representative to speak on the artist's behalf.

The committee will choose an artist six to twelve months before the exhibition and confirm dates for the exhibit. Art Committee members will interview the artist about the evolution of their work and photograph the artist in their studio to promote the exhibition. A selection of works will be curated by the artist, with input from committee members, and may include pieces borrowed from private collections as well as works available for purchase."

The library will handle all sales. 25% of the sales price will be gifted to the library as a donation; artists will receive the remaining 75%. The artist is responsible for reporting/paying the applicable taxes.

The committee will install the exhibition, promote the event, and host a public reception in the gallery.
